

# VTAL51805G AlkaGent, Alkaline Cage Wash Detergent

A versatile low-foaming detergent specifically designed for animal cage washers and manual wash.

## Precautionary Statements:

- Wash hands and exposed areas thoroughly after handling
- Wear eye protection, protective gloves
- If on skin: Wash with plenty of water
- If in eyes: Rinse cautiously with warm water for several minutes
- Use with adequate ventilation. Avoid breathing vapors, spray or mist
- Store in a cool dry place. Keep partially used containers closed and away from heat and humidity. Do not exceed storage temperature of (50 °C) 120°F. Keep out of reach of children.
- Eye protection: Safety glasses are required
- Skin protection: Gloves are required

- Hygiene measures: Handle in accordance with good industrial hygiene and safety practice
- Dispose of in accordance with local, state and federal regulations

## In Case of Fire:

- Extinguish Mode: Use extinguishing measures appropriate to local circumstances and surrounding environment.

## First Aid:

- Ingestion: Do NOT induce vomiting. Drink cool water. Transport to an emergency medical center. Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
- Inhalation: Move victim to fresh air. Seek medical attention immediately.

## Directions for Use:

Use 1/4 to 2 ounce per gallon of water depending on the type of equipment used, water conditions, and type of debris.
